THEME: The Rhythms of Nature

Surrounded by the historic and spectacular beauty of Banff National Park, the 15th annual Ice Magic International Ice Sculpture Competition invites teams to help depict the fine balance of life within the Canadian Rockies. From the ebb and flow of mountains and glaciers, fire as a life breathing force, predator and prey and the inter-wildlife struggle, or through historical conquest and exploration, the cycle and rhythms of nature are constantly changing within this fragile environment.

As Teams work within this theme, they will be allowed 15 blocks of ice and 30 hours to complete their design. In addition to their carving, each team will also be required to write a brief summary on the key messages they are portraying through their ice sculptures.

EVENTS:

International Ice Sculpture Team Competition – NICA Sanctioned Event

Carvers begin at 8am, January 23 and have until 2:00pm January 25 to complete their sculpture.

One Carver, One Block, One Hour

A speed competition where one member from each team will be required to compete, with a prize of \$1000. Time of event is from 4:00pm – 5:00pm at the Lake Louise Inn on Saturday, January 24. Ice Magic will provide transportation for the carvers to the competition site. Please allow for two hours including the competition and travel time.
